Ramp Builds

We welcome all levels of experience and a wide variety of ages from youth to seniors. We typically build on Saturday mornings. Anticipate a time commitment of four to five hours.

Project Managers

If you enjoy planning details and leading others, you may be a good candidate for a Project Manager. The Project Manager plans, coordinates, and ensures details as time allows throughout the week or so prior to the build.

Hospitality Team

If you enjoy meeting new people and making connections, this is the perfect opportunity for you. Serving on the hospitality team, you will meet at the build site and offer refreshments to the volunteers and ramp recipient at the end of the build to celebrate their newfound freedom.

Survey Team

Before we build a ramp, a team of two individuals visit the site to determine if the ramp can be built and draw a plan. Site surveys are done at your convenience.

Finishing & Inspection Crew

Once ramps are completed, a finishing crew routs and sands the ramp handrails. It takes a crew of two to four volunteers to finish each job. With a little planning, multiple jobs can be completed in two to three hours.

Customer Service Representative (CSR)

CSRs are the main point of contact to pre-qualify people who request a ramp. They work with the client to ensure we have the necessary information to complete their ramp request. This is a great opportunity for those who enjoy talking on the phone and connecting with others.

Office Assistants

If your gift is administrative or writing, we can use your help with mailings, general office assistance, database management or blog writing. This is a great opportunity to volunteer remotely.

Photographer/Videographer

If you are skilled behind the camera, we would love your assistance in capturing the spirit of our mission. Volunteer to take photos at build sites, in the warehouse and at events. Capture the moment of joy when a client goes down their ramp for the first time.
